The next in line to get a facelift is Bandirma Park. Located in the most dynamic region of Turkey, a design competition invites competitors to generate ideas for developing a park cultivating the notion of spatial design and planning as well as creating a recreational centre at the regional scale. Bandırma, a candidate to relieve some of Istanbul's growing population burden, is showing significant advances in becoming an important industry and logistic centre within the region. Once the new port project for the city has been completed and the rail and road links have been connected, it is expected to become Turkey's portal to Europe. Thus Bandirma Park, located 1 km from Bandirma's city centre will aim to serve as both a recreational area to enrich daily life and as a space for local design schools.
